## North Suburban YMCA Welcomes New Health Speaker Series from Northwestern Medicine

**Northbrook, IL: February 2016** – The North Suburban YMCA and Northwestern Medicine will partner for a new Speaker Series on news and trends in health. These informational presentations, offered to the public free of charge, will bring leading medical professionals to the Y for engaging discussions and helpful tips. The Speaker Series is part of the Y's newly expanded Adult Education and Support programs.

In keeping with the theme of February being American Heart Health Month, the first Northwestern Medicine presentation on February 26 will focus on the treatment of high blood pressure. Dr. Elyse T. Esrig, an internal medicine specialist, and Dr. Micah J. Eimer, a cardiologist, will discuss the changing definition of high blood pressure, the plethora of medications used to treat it, and lifestyle approaches that may help reduce it. Free blood pressure screenings will be available. The session begins at 9:30am on Friday, February 26 at the YMCA, located at 2705 Techny Road in Northbrook. The presentation is free of charge, with no advance registration required.

Future presentations in 2016 will cover topics like allergy treatment, back-to-school exams, flu prevention, and skin cancer screenings.
