TIPS FOR REGISTERING

Please note that grades refer to what grade your child(ren) will be entering for the Fall 2024 school year. Online registration is not available for camp. All camp registration forms need to be dropped off at the NSYMCA or emailed to registrar@nsymca.org. Registration is first come, first served.

Please complete all camp registrations in full (including payment information). All incomplete registrations will be pulled and lose their place in the registration queue.

Please allow 5 business days for processing.

TRADITIONAL VS SPECIALTY

Full Day registered Traditional Campers attend full day field trips each Thursday. If you are a half day Traditional day camper, you do not attend the Thursday field trips. If you are in a specialty camp, you do not attend the Thursday field trip.

Free swim is M, W, F in the afternoons for Traditional Camp only. If you are registered for 'AM only' or register for a PM Specialty Camp, your child will not swim.

Swim Lessons are on Tuesdays. They are an optional add on. They are available for Traditional Camp only. If you are registered for a Specialty Camp only, you can not register for swim lessons that given week. If you are registered for half day Traditional, you may register for swim lessons.

Camp Add-On Programs & Services

EXTENDED CAMP (Before and After Camp)

The Before and After Camp atmosphere is relaxed, safe, and fun! Activities range from indoor and outdoor free play to organized activities such as crafts and games. Before Camp is from 7:30–8:45 am and After Camp is from 4:10–6:00 pm. You can register for one or both. Extended Camp is for Kindergarten and older. No minimum days required. Can be prorated.

LUNCH BUNCH

Lunch Bunch is NOT required for any camper who attends an 'AM only' camp and a 'PM only' camp. We provide lunch supervision and transitioning at no additional charge.

Add Lunch Bunch and extend your camp day for half day registered campers only! Campers from kindergarten and up can enjoy lunch time with their friends and be supervised by well-trained staff. Lunch Bunch is open to all campers registered for an AM or PM camp with supervision. Campers must bring a lunch Monday–Thursday, while a special lunch is provided on Fridays. No minimum days required. Can be prorated.

SWIM LESSONS

Add Swim Lessons to your camp day. It is available for 1-day a week on Tuesday. Available to Traditional & Sports only. Financial Assistance is not available. \$30 per lesson (Member) & \$35 per lesson (Non-Member), per child for sign up.

GENERAL CAMP INFORMATION

REGISTRATION

- To guarantee your camper's spot, register early.
- Registrations are first-come, first served upon availability of space; some camps have limited availability.
- Registration forms may be submitted in person, by mail, fax or by emailing to registrar@nsymca.org.
- All registrations must be completely filled out in order to be processed. Missing information will delay your registration and spots are not held. Any registration questions will be communicated via email and will delay registration.
- The NSYMCA has the right to deny entrance to a camper if fees are not paid and up to date.
- Camp registrations for any given week are due by 12 pm on the Wednesday prior to that week. Any registrations after this time will not be accepted. For details or more information, email registrar@nsymca.org.
- A non-refundable associated fee of 3% will be added to all credit card transactions. Avoid the fee by paying with cash or check.

PAYMENT PLANS -MEMBERS ONLY

- Payment Plans require a \$100 deposit per child at the time of registration.
- Payment Plans can begin any month, but must start by June. All must END by July 15th.
- We have two draft dates available for families to customize what works best for you. You can choose the 1st or the 15th to draft your payment plan.
- Once your registration is processed, you will receive an email that breaks down your payment plan. This is your confirmation of registration.
- A \$25 NSF fee will be charged for any payment that is returned by the bank. As a courtesy, one fee will be waived per calendar year.

WITHDRAWAL/TRANSFERS/CHANGES

- All camp cancellations and transfers will be subject to a \$30.00 processing fee everytime a change is made (fee applied once per request).
- All withdrawal, transfers and change requests must be made in writing. These can be submitted in person or through email.
- Refunds may be considered in unique circumstances and granted by the director at their discretion.
- Refunds are subject to detailed policies outlined in our parent guide.
- Starting June 1st, all withdrawals will forfeit all fees paid to date.

WAIT LIST

- Registrations received after a camp is full and has reached capacity will be put on the wait-list.
- Families will receive an email to be given the option to choose an alternative camp.
- Once on the wait list, if a spot becomes available you will receive an email giving 24 hours to claim your spot. If we do not receive any contact, we will move on to the next camper.
- All waitlist enrollments after April 1st are subject to standard rates. (Even if you were waitlisted prior.)

DISCOUNTS

- \$10 multi-child discount will be given, per week, when 2 or more children are registered. This is forfeited if the registration is withdrawn.
