- Cooking Camps Chef Rachel returns with 4 new culinary camp adventures, including camps based around popular television shows liked "Chopped" and "Nailed It."
- Full Day Navigators For our oldest campers, Navigators is now full day only, allowing more time for travel, activities, and fun.
- Legends Sports Camp has expanded adding a new camp group this year.

NSYMCA camps deliver flexibility and value that appeals to parents. Campers can sign up for sessions by the week, accommodating family schedules and allowing children to explore a variety of programs. The Y offers half-day and full-day camps, before and after-camp childcare, and payment plans; financial assistance is available for families in need.
