Maddie Sadlowski-Van Horn began her formal art education in High School and then pursued a degree in painting and received her bachelor's from University of Illinois, Champaign-Urbana. Sadlowski-Van Horn furthered her education in printmaking and illustration from the Academy of Art in Chicago.

Sadlowski-Van Horn's work includes public murals, gallery showings and commissioned custom artwork and portraits. Using strong drawing skills and oil paints, Sadlowski-Van Horn works the "entire canvas", contrasting light to dark forms, in order to get a balanced composition.

"My inspiration for my work is nature itself," says Sadlowski-Van Horn. "The feelings I have towards it, which I record with photographs I take myself," continues Sadlowski-Van Horn. "Something intrigues me inside about the beauty and mystery in nature, knowing it is the Creators handiwork!

Sadlowski-Van Horn was born in Wyomissing, PA, but has spent most of her life in Glen Ellyn, IL and now lives in the northwest suburbs of Chicago.
