Camp Registration Timeline:

- **12/1/25:** Active Member Registration begins (current NSYMCA members as of 10/1/24 and prior members)
- **01/02/26:** New Member Registration begins (members with active NSYMCA membership after 10/2/24)
- **02/02/26:** Non-Member Registration begins

All camps are led by highly trained counselors under the guidance of **Camp Director Ricky Gonzalez**, who brings over 18 years of camp management experience to his seventh summer at the NSYMCA.
